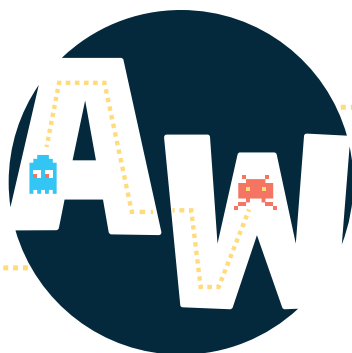

THURSDAY

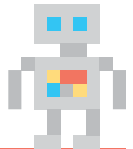
Bible Story: Fruit of the Spirit • Galatians 5:22-23
