1 Corinthians 12:12-26

2. How can you use technology to stay connected to the church, the body of all Christians?

LIVE IT

Have you ever been part of a team? It may have been a sports team, a school band, a project group or a team playing a video game. Even being part of a family makes you part of a team! You've probably heard the phrase teamwork makes the dream work, but sometimes actually doing that can be hard. God knows this, and He shares the verses in 1 Corinthians to help us work better as a team.

The church is a team, but on an even deeper scale. God says we're all part of the same body. He wants us to be united in our minds and our purpose (Philippians 2:2). This can be difficult when things are normal, but how can we do that while we're social distancing? This is where technology comes in! You can stay connected to the people in your community through Zoom, Facetime, calls, texting, online gaming and many other ways.

Pray through how God wants to use this time to keep you connected to people. You can also ask God how He wants to use you during this time to help others. We may not be meeting face-to-face, but God can still use us to love others and be His hands and feet.
