### In Class This Month

### School Pictures

### Morning Drop-off

When walking your children into school in the morning, please remember our walking feet inside rule. We know it's tempting to race, but with over 200 children, someone could get hurt, and we don't want it to be you! This is one of our school rules that teachers will work on with the entire class. Please make sure to speak to your child's teacher so they are aware your child has arrived. It's important that your child arrives before 9 am, as our teaching day starts at 9 am.

### Sick Child

Please refer to your Parent Handbook for questions about a sick child. If your child has a fever of 100.4 or higher, they must go home and may not return to school until they are fever-free without fever-reducing medications for 24 hours. Also, if your child is too ill to participate in the classroom and playground activities, they should stay home or will be sent home until they feel better.

### Pickup

For your child's safety, if you have different plans for your child's pickup, please let our staff know. You can also call the office and let us know by either speaking to us or leaving a message. In our Playground app, please add any authorized guardians/pickups to your child's profile. We check authorized pickups and their ID's at the office before allowing pickup.

### Lunch

When preparing your child's lunch for school, please remember that heat-up items may not be heated for more than 30 seconds. Send two snacks a day and a water bottle. Limit juice or milk to breakfast and/or lunch. For classes 2 and older, these are not served throughout the day. Please remember to pack utensils, and do not send soda or candy.
